/Description of Application/	<p>Premises Variation</p> <p>This variation is to <u>remove some areas within the layout presently on the existing</u> premises licence (867m²) that are not applicable to the licensable activities; marked in grey & green on the plan.</p> <p>At the same time, <u>increase the licensed area layout by including a new portable outside bar to service the demands of the outside seating area (390m²);</u> marked in yellow on the plan; thus, enabling the area to be controlled/supervised by the existing modified conditions consistent with the operating schedule.</p> <p>Extend the times the licence authorises the carrying out of licensable activities on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve to 02:00hrs</p> <p>The whole of ANNEX 2 – CONDITIONS CONSISTANT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE to be removed and <u>replaced with a more up to date variation</u> that will better address the four licensing objectives.</p>

In accordance with S.158 of the Licensing Act 2003:

A person commits an offence if he knowingly or recklessly makes a false statement in or in connection with an application for the grant, variation, transfer or review of a premises licence or club premises certificate, an application for a provisional statement. A person guilty of an offence under section 158 is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale.
